

*Minutes of the Presidential Committee on Athletics*

*Conference Room N101, Hawkeye Tennis & Recreation Center*

*November 2, 2017*

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m. by Chair Hollingworth.

**I. Welcome - PCA Chair Hollingworth**

- A.** Chair Hollingworth stated the electronic vote on revisions to the Online Course Policy was approved by PCA last week; however, further discussion on the policy will take place today during the Academic Achievement Subcommittee's report.
- B.** PCA members who would like a copy of the 2017-18 Big Ten Conference Handbook should contact Parker.

**II. Head Coach Introductions - Sasha Schmid and Ross Wilson**

Coaches Schmid and Wilson introduced themselves to Committee members. Each had been an assistant coach at Iowa before advancing to the head coach position; Schmid was also a UI tennis student-athlete. They spoke about the Hawkeye Tennis & Recreation Center, the amenities provided within the facility, and the cooperation among the Recreational Services staff, UI community representatives, and Athletics Department staff to schedule the facility to meet everyone's needs.

Chair Hollingworth added PCA members' questions can be posed to the tennis coaches during the tour of the facility. She thanked both coaches for their reports.

***III. Approval of the October 5, 2017, PCA Minutes***

Rhodes moved to approve the October 5, 2017, PCA minutes; Dillavou seconded. Committee members voted unanimously to approve the document.

***IV. Athletics Department Searches - PCA Vice Chair Dillavou***

No staff searches are underway per Dillavou. The most recent hire was a career specialist/academic coordinator in Student-Athlete Academic Services.

***V. Subcommittee Updates***

***A. Student-Athlete Well-Being - Bruhn***

No report.

***B. Academic Achievement - Bowden***

Chair Bowden led the discussion on the Academic Achievement Subcommittee's recommendation to further revise the Online Course Policy. The proposed language follows: "It is the policy of the PCA that student-athletes must enroll in a minimum of three semester hours in a traditional face-to-face course each Spring and Fall semester. Only online courses offered by the UI may be used by student-athletes toward meeting progress toward degree requirements for athletics eligibility. Exceptions to this policy must be approved by the Associate Director for Student-Athlete Academic Services in consultation with the Faculty Athletics Representative and the Chair of the Academic Achievement Subcommittee of the PCA."

Discussion ensued in support of the proposed language and questions posed were addressed. Chair Hollingworth called for a motion. Kelly moved for approval of the proposed language; Bowden seconded. Unanimous approval was recorded.

Chair Hollingworth will update the PCA Operations Manual immediately.

***C. Equity - Matheson***

Clerry met with Equity Subcommittee members to discuss student-athlete participation numbers, scholarships, and equity. Her report explained the different measures used to count student-athlete participants when reports are submitted to the Office of Civil Rights, the National Collegiate Athletic Association, and the Equity in Athletics Disclosure Act.

Chair Matheson stated Tovar will present at the subcommittee's next meeting. She will address minority student-athlete involvement in government and leadership; she will also talk about student-athlete exit interviews.

**VI. ISAAC Report - Colin**

Guagliardo presented for Colin who was competing at Purdue.

A leadership program entitled, “Heart of a Leader” took place Sunday, October 29, 2017, in Carver-Hawkeye Arena. The event was well attended. Guagliardo read comments from Colin who described the event as a good means to get to know one another as well as yourself. His remarks were very positive and encouraging. A discussion on the program will continue at the next ISAAC Executive Committee meeting. Kudos were attributed to Kara Park, Senior Associate Director for Student-Athlete Academic Services - Student Development and Events, for her coordination of this event.

**VII. NCAA Report - Burke**

Discussion regarding student-athlete transfers continues among NCAA Transfer Working Group members per Burke.

**VIII. Athletics Director’s Report - Burke**

- A. Burke noted Barta is recovering and sends his regards to the PCA.
- B. Soccer, field hockey, men’s golf, women’s golf, men’s golf, and rowing are done competing this fall. Women’s tennis has one more match. The men’s and women’s cross country teams are nearing their finish. The men’s and women’s swimming and diving teams are still competing. The sports reports and schedules are appended.

Upcoming home events are: men’s basketball tonight, volleyball Friday night and Sunday, football on Saturday, and women’s basketball on Sunday.

- C. Two facility feasibility studies are underway. One involves a potential wrestling practice facility; the other study encompasses a possible softball stadium.
- D. Courter inquired on the status of the Finkbine clubhouse project. Burke asked Hankins to update the Committee since he is attending these meetings. The project is currently in architectural design phase. Current timeline has design documents to be completed by mid-November, construction documents to be completed by mid-December with the project going out to bid for general construction contractor by mid-January. Construction is scheduled to start in spring of 2018 and to be completed by spring of 2019.

**IX. Adjourn**

Chair Hollingworth announced the business portion of the meeting is complete and opened the floor to Coaches Schmid and Wilson for further comments. Both spoke highly of the facility and of a video system installed recently, which allows matches to be live-streamed so parents/fans can watch matches if they are unable to attend. The University of Iowa will be the host site for the Big Ten Men’s Tennis Championships in 2018. A tour of the facility followed.

Chair Hollingworth adjourned the meeting at 5:07 p.m.

# NOVEMBER REPORT TO THE PRESIDENTIAL COMMITTEE ON ATHLETICS

## MEN'S CROSS COUNTRY

**Head Coach:** Randy Hasenbank

**Next Event:** Nov. 10 at the NCAA Midwest Regional in Ames, Iowa.

**Notables:** The Hawkeyes placed 10th at the Big Ten Championships with 235 points, a 106-point improvement from last season. Six Hawkeyes showed year-over-year improvements in place at the Big Ten Championships. Sophomore Nathan Mylenek was Iowa's top runner. He placed 28<sup>th</sup> overall and has led the men in four of five races this season.

## WOMEN'S CROSS COUNTRY

**Head Coach:** Randy Hasenbank

**Next Event:** Nov. 10 at the NCAA Midwest Regional in Ames, Iowa.

**Notables:** Iowa placed 11<sup>th</sup> at the Big Ten Championships with 303 points. Five Hawkeyes showed year-over-year improvement from last season. Junior Andrea Shine was Iowa's top runner. She placed 29<sup>th</sup> overall, and has led Iowa in all five races this season.

## FIELD HOCKEY

**Season Record:** 7-11 overall, 3-5 B1G

**Head Coach:** Lisa Cellucci

**Notables:** Sophomore Katie Birch surpassed single-season career highs in goals, assists, and points this season. She tallied 11 goals, four assists, and 26 points in 17 matches in 2016 on her way to becoming Big Ten Freshmen of the Year. In her sophomore campaign, Birch has registered 14 goals, eight assists, and 36 points in 18 matches. Her 14 goals currently rank third in the Big Ten Conference.

Five of Iowa's seven freshmen found the scoresheet this season. Maddy Murphy leads the class in all categories with 11 goals, three assists, and 25 points. Lizzy Cimilluca (two), Ellie Holley (one), Mya Christopher (three), and Nikki Freeman (two) also chipped in goals for the Hawkeyes this season.

## FOOTBALL

**Season Record:** 5-3 overall, 2-3 B1G

**Head Coach:** Kirk Ferentz

**Next Event:** Saturday vs. Ohio State - 2:35 p.m., at Kinnick Stadium - Iowa City, Iowa

**Notables:** The Hawkeyes have played a number of close games in building a 5-3 overall record. Iowa is 1-1 in overtime, has won a single game by seven points and lost two games by seven points.

Iowa won all three of its nonconference games, including a 44-41 overtime win at Iowa State. In Big Ten play the Hawkeyes have wins over Illinois and Minnesota. The victories over the Gophers and Cyclones assured the Hawkeyes of keeping the Cy-Hawk Trophy and Floyd of Rosedale in Iowa City for another year.

Following Saturday's home game, the Hawkeyes travel to Wisconsin on Nov. 11 and return home to host Purdue on Nov. 18 in the final home game of the season.

Senior linebacker Josey Jewell has earned both preseason and midseason All-America honors from multiple media outlets.

**Notables:** The Championship 8+ crew finished eighth among university entries at the Head of the Charles Regatta. The field boasted some of the best college teams in the nation, including four National Training Center crews from the US, Canada, and the Netherlands, and the "Great Eight" which was comprised of eight of the top rowers from around the world.

The Championship 4+ crew finished sixth overall at the Head of the Charles Regatta in a strong field that had the top four crews breaking the course record.

The Novice Eight "A" crew won their event with a time of 13:32.28.

## SOCCER

**Season Record:** 9-8-2 Overall, 4-5-2 B1G

**Head Coach:** Dave Dilanni

**Notables:** The Iowa soccer team qualified for the Big Ten Tournament for the first time since 2014. The Hawkeyes closed out the regular season with a 4-2-1 record to earn the No. 8 seed via a tiebreaker. Iowa fell in the Big Ten Tournament to top-seeded Ohio State, 2-1, in double overtime. Sophomore Natalie Winters earned third-team All-Big Ten honors, while Rachele Armand was Iowa's Big Ten Sportsmanship Award recipient. Sophomore Devin Burns finished the season with nine goals and 23 points to rank in the top 10 in a single season in school history.

## MEN'S SWIMMING & DIVING

**Season Record:** 2-0 Overall, 2-0 B1G

**Head Coach:** Marc Long

**Next Event:** Friday at Purdue

**Notables:** The Hawkeyes opened their 2017-18 season defeating Michigan State (195-100) on Oct. 5-6, and No. 21 Minnesota (162-138) on Oct. 27. Junior Kenneth Mende leads the Hawkeyes in the 100 back, 200 back, and 200 IM. Freshman diver Anton Hoherz posted a 3-meter score of 383.50 against Minnesota that ranks third in the UI record books.

## WOMEN'S SWIMMING & DIVING

**Season Record:** 2-1 Overall, 1-1 B1G

**Head Coach:** Marc Long

**Next Event:** Friday at Purdue

**Notables:** The Hawkeyes opened their 2017-18 season defeating Michigan State (189-108) and Northern Iowa (184-113) on Oct. 5-6. Sophomore freestyler Hannah Burvill leads Iowa in the 100 free, 200 free, 500 free, and has been a part of the leading 200 and 400 free relays this season. Junior Jacintha Thomas leads the Hawkeyes in the diving well on the 1-meter, while freshman Jayah Mathews is leading on the 3-meter.

## MEN'S TENNIS

**Head Coach:** Ross Wilson

**Next Event:** Jan. 19 vs. Marquette & Western Michigan - Iowa City, Iowa

**Notables:** Senior Josh Silverstein came into the fall season rated No. 66 in the country. Sophomore Kareem Allaf advanced to the Round of 16 at the ITA Regionals. Freshmen Will Davies and Piotr Smietana finished second at the Big Ten Indoor Championships in doubles. In singles action UI advanced a Big Ten-best five student-athletes to the Round of 16 as well.

## **WOMEN'S TENNIS**

**Head Coach:** Sasha Schmid

**Next Event:** Nov. 10-12 at Florida State Invite

**Notables:** Senior Zoe Douglas came into the fall season ranked No. 92, while sophomore Elise van Heuvelen came in ranked No. 117 nationally in singles. Douglas and van Heuvelen started the fall season ranked No. 42 in doubles in the ITA preseason rankings. Freshman Yufei Long advanced to semifinals of the Milwaukee Tennis Classic. Zoe Douglas reached the quarterfinals of the ITA Central Regionals. Douglas and van Heuvelen paired up to reach the doubles quarterfinals at the ITA Central Regionals. The Hawkeyes are 14-11 in doubles.

## **VOLLEYBALL**

**Season Record:** 15-10 Overall, 4-8 B1G

**Head Coach:** Bond Shymansky

**Next Event:** Friday vs. Indiana at 7 p.m. - Carver-Hawkeye Arena - Iowa City

**Notables:** The Hawkeyes shattered their all-time attendance record as 4,729 fans watched Iowa take on No. 4 Nebraska on Oct. 7. Iowa's previous single-match attendance record was 4,131 (No. 1 Nebraska on Nov. 19, 2016).

Senior Jess Janota collected her 1,000th career kill against Northwestern on Oct. 21. She has 1,013 career kills, a mark which ranks No. 18 in the record books.

Freshman Brie Orr has taken charge of the Hawkeye offense, posting a career-high 59 assists against No. 22 Michigan on Oct. 4. With 956 assists this season, Orr has just 44 assists to hit the 1,000-mark milestone.
