Chair Zaharis called the meeting to order at 4:01 pm.

**I. Approval of the September 1, 2022, PCA Minutes**

Petty moved to approve September 1, 2022, minutes; Jim Torner seconded the motion. Unanimous approval was recorded from the Committee.

**II. Head Coach Introduction – Lisa Bluder**

Chair Zaharis introduced Coach Bluder, highlighting her extraordinary career at Iowa.

Bluder thanked the Committee for having her come speak. Bluder began by addressing the numerous successes coming from their previous season including the Big Ten Regular Season Championship and Big Ten Tournament Championship, also addressing the Carver sell-outs and the tremendous fan engagement.

Bluder continued moving into the upcoming year by discussing preseason polls, roster, injuries, the transfer portal, and NIL opportunities within the team.

Bluder opened the floor to questions, questions were received and answered regarding the WNBA, recruiting in Iowa, NIL money, the expansion of USC and UCLA, and national exposure with the upcoming TV schedule.

Chair Zaharis thanked Coach Bluder for speaking to the Committee.

***III. Guest Speaker – Lorenda Holston (DEI)***

Lorenda Holston was introduced to the Committee as the new Assistant Athletics Director for Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion. Holston gave an update on the DEI Action Plan and the importance of aligning this document with the university, conference, and NCAA goals.

Lorenda spoke about a new member to the Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion space with Anthony Embry joining the team. Embry's position will be student-facing, focusing on student-athlete conversations and working with affinity groups.

Liz Hollingworth shared a recent experience on a Big Ten Equality call with an Iowa student-athlete speaking highly of her experience at Iowa and specifically the affinity groups.


Barta continued by addressing the Gender Equity Monitor Report and the path to how the report was completed. Barta and Burke opened the floor to any questions on the Equity Report process.

# OCTOBER REPORT TO THE PRESIDENTIAL COMMITTEE ON ATHLETICS

## CROSS COUNTRY

**Head Coach:** Randy Hasenbank

**Next Event:** Oct. 15 at Weis-Crockett Invite - Stillwater, Okla.

**Notables:** The Hawkeyes competed in two events in September - the Redbird Invite and the Gans Creek Classic. The Redbird Invite was an opportunity to gain experience, while the Gans Creek Classic provided a preview to the NCAA Midwest Regional Course. The men finished sixth and seventh, respectively, at the two events. The women finished seventh and sixth, respectively.

Sophomore Max Murphy set a personal best and broke into the Top 10 all-time list at Iowa with his 8,000-meter performance at Gans Creek (23:44). He placed fourth overall and ranks sixth all time in Iowa history. Junior Nick Trattner added a collegiate best 23:56.

Senior Emma Gordon finished Gans Creek with a 6,000-meter time of 20:53.6, good for 10th all-time at Iowa. She led the Hawkeyes to a sixth place finish out of 22 teams.

## FIELD HOCKEY

**Head Coach:** Lisa Cellucci

**Season Record:** 9-2 Overall (3-1 B1G)

**Next Event:** Friday at Penn State - 5 p.m.

**Notables:** Iowa is currently 9-2 overall and 3-1 in the Big Ten Conference after posting a 7-1 record during the month of September. The Hawkeyes posted three wins over nationally ranked foes, including knocking off No. 1 Northwestern in Evanston by the score of 2-0. It was the second straight year the program has defeated a No. 1 ranked opponent.

Iowa's perfect September ended when No. 4 Maryland downed the Hawkeyes, 2-1 in overtime, on Sept. 30 at Grant Field.

Two Hawkeyes – Grace McGuire and Alex Wesneski – garnered Big Ten weekly honors on Sept. 26. McGuire was the Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week and Wesneski earned offensive honors. It was Iowa's second and third weekly honor this season and Anthe Nijziel was the Defensive Player of the Week on Sept. 12.

Wesneski is leading the team with 11 goals this season, which are a career high. The Pennsylvania native is second nationally in goals this season.

Defensively, Iowa has five shutouts on the season with McGuire posting a 0.83 goals against average while making 37 saves.

## FOOTBALL

**Head Coach:** Kirk Ferentz

**Season Record:** 3-2 Overall (1-1 B1G)

**Next Event:** Saturday at Illinois - 6:40 p.m.

**Notables:** Iowa is 3-2 on the season after a 27-14 loss to No. 4 Michigan. The Hawkeyes are 1-1 in Big Ten play, having won at Rutgers the previous week by a 27-10 final score. The Hawkeyes travel to Illinois Saturday for their third night game of the season, and then have an open date on the schedule on Oct. 15.

The Iowa defense has led the way to date, as the defense is nationally ranked in several categories. Senior linebacker Jack Campbell leads the team in tackles, while sophomore Cooper DeJean leads the way with three interceptions.

DeJean had a 45-yard interception return for a touchdown at Rutgers, keeping alive an amazing streak for the Iowa defense: Iowa has had at least one interception return for a touchdown in 15 consecutive seasons.

Senior Kaevon Merriweather had a 30-yard fumble return for a touchdown as well in the win at Rutgers, and also recorded a 33-yard interception return.

Junior punter Tory Taylor had led Iowa's special teams, as he leads the Big Ten and ranks fifth nationally in punting average at 47.4 yards per punt.

Following the open date on the schedule Iowa plays at Ohio State on Oct. 22 before hosting Northwestern in the annual homecoming game on Oct. 29 (2 or 2:30 p.m., BTN).

## MEN'S GOLF

**Head Coach:** Tyler Stith

**Next Event:** Oct. 10-11 at Purdue Invite – West Lafayette, Ind.

**Notables:** The Hawkeyes have competed in two fall events to date, placing 12th at the Fighting Irish Classic and 12th at the Inverness Intercollegiate.

Senior Mac McClear led Iowa with a 209 score, finishing one-under par through the 54 hole event at Notre Dame. He also led the team at the Inverness event, placing 20th with a score of six over par.

Iowa will compete in three additional fall events, including hosting the Iowa Fall Classic, Oct. 16-17 at Blue Top Ridge in Riverside, Iowa.

## **WOMEN'S GOLF**

**Head Coach:** Megan Menzel

**Next Event:** Friday-Sunday at Ron Moore Intercollegiate -- Highlands Ranch, Colo.

**Notables:** The Hawkeyes tied for 10th at the Badger Invitational with a 54-hole total of 904 in their second tournament of the fall season. Freshman Shannyn Vogler led the team, tallying the first top 20 finish of her career. Vogler tied for 16th place with a three-over par 219 with rounds of 73-72-74.

## **WOMEN'S SOCCER**

**Head Coach:** Dave Dilanni

**Season Record:** 3-5-5 Overall (0-2-3 B1G)

**Next Event:** Sunday at Minnesota - 1 p.m.

**Notables:** The Hawkeyes have tied in three out of the last four Big Ten matches. It's latest match against Michigan, Iowa shutout the Wolverines for 86 minutes before drawing a red card that would allow Michigan an opportunity to win. Senior Hailey Rydberg scored early and now leads the team in overall points (10) and is tied for most goals this year (3).

## **VOLLEYBALL**

**Head Coach:** Jim Barnes

**Season Record:** 6-9 Overall (0-4 B1G)

**Next Event:** Wednesday at No. 5 Purdue - 5 p.m.

**Notables:** Iowa opened a competitive B1G slate with three of their first four matches being against ranked opponents. They return to Xstream Arena on Saturday to host Indiana at 2 p.m. CT.

Senior libero Mari Hinkle averages 4.49 digs per set which leads the conference. She is second in the conference in total digs registering 229 thus far. Senior middle hitter Amiya Jones is ranked sixth in the conference for total aces (20) and tenth for aces per set (.38). Redshirt senior setter Lily Tessier is ranked eighth in the Big Ten in total assists (422) and ninth in assists per set (8.27).
