
IX. Athletic Director's Report - Barta





NOVEMBER REPORT TO THE PRESIDENTIAL COMMITTEE ON ATHLETICS

CROSS COUNTRY

Head Coach: Randy Hasenbank

Next Event: Nov. 11 at NCAA Midwest Regional - Columbia,

Mo.

Notables: The Hawkeyes competed at the Illini Open for the final regular season event of the year on October 21. Freshman Ana Barroso paced the Hawkeye women in the 5,000-meter race, finishing 8th overall (18:37.5). Freshman Carson Houg led the Hawkeye men with a 15th place finish (25:49.4) in the 8,000-meter event. The B1G Championships took place in Ann Arbor, Mich., on October 28. Junior Nick Trattner led the Hawkeye men in the 8,000-meter race with a 29th place finish (24:54.6). The lowa men finished seventh with 225 points. The women's team was paced by senior Emma Gordon (21:38.7) in the 6,000-meter event. The women's team finished 14th with 402 points.

FIELD HOCKEY

Head Coach: Lisa Cellucci

Season Record: 11-6 Overall (4-4 B1G)

Next Event: Thursday vs. Michigan at Big Ten Tournament

- 10 a.m. (CT) - Columbus, Ohio

Notables: The Hawkeyes closed out the regular season with a 1-0 shutout victory over Michigan State on Oct. 28 at Grant Field. Iowa limited the Spartans to two shots (one SOG) en route to its sixth shutout of the season.

Sophomore Annika Herbine scored the game's lone goal in the 32nd-minute, getting her stick on a rebound off a penalty corner. It was her eighth goal of the season.

lowa is the No. 5 seed in the Big Ten Tournament, where it will face No. 4 seed Michigan in quarterfinal action. It will be the third meeting between the two teams in a 2 ½ week stretch. The Wolverines won 2-0 in Ann Arbor on Oct. 16 and 1-0 in Evanston, III., in a neutral site matchup on Oct. 23.

FOOTBALL

Head Coach: Kirk Ferentz

Season Record: 4-4 Overall (2-3 B1G)

Next Event: Saturday at Purdue - 11:03 a.m. (CT)

Notables: Iowa is 4-4 on the season after a 33-3 Homecoming win over Northwestern. The Hawkeyes are 2-3 in Big Ten play, with two of the losses coming to teams ranked in the top four in the nation.

The Iowa defense has led the way to date, and is nationally ranked in several categories. Senior linebacker Jack Campbell leads the team in tackles, while sophomore Cooper DeJean leads the way with three interceptions.

Campbell has earned national recognition with his performances on the field and academically. He is one of 15

finalists for the William V. Campbell Trophy, considered the Heisman Trophy of academics. In addition Campbell is a semifinal candidate for the Chuck Bednarik Award and the Dick Butkus Award for his play on the field.

The lowa offense had its best performance of the season in the most recent outing. Senior quarterback Spencer Petras completed 21-30 pass attempts for 220 yards, with one passing touchdown and one rushing score.

True freshman kicker Drew Stevens was named Big Ten Conference Freshman of the Week following the Northwestern game, as he connected on 4-4 field goals and 3-3 PATs. Stevens' connected on a 54-yard field goal, which ties as the seventh longest in program history. For the season he has made 11-12 field goal attempts.

Following Saturday's contest at Purdue the Hawkeyes return home Nov. 12 to host Wisconsin (TBA).

MEN'S GOLF

Head Coach: Tyler Stith

Notables: The Hawkeyes won the Iowa Fall Classic at Riverside. All seven Hawkeyes that competed finished top 25 on the leaderboard.

Senior Mac McClear led the tournament wire-to-wire, shooting even-par (72) to finish at 214 (-2) through 54 holes. The former Big Ten Champion earned his third career medalist honor, outpacing the competition by three strokes. The Iowa Fall Classic marks McClear's second top-five finish in as many weeks. His three-career individual titleS are the most since current Iowa volunteer assistant Steven Ihm achieved four medalist honors in 2014. Iowa also competed in the Williams Cup to round out the month of October.

WOMEN'S GOLF

Head Coach: Megan Menzel

Next Event: Jan. 27-30 vs. Colorado – Seal Beach, Calif. **Notables:** The Hawkeyes closed out their fall season with a 15th place finish at the Marilynn Smith Sunflower Invitational in Lawrence, Kan. The tournament was shortened to 45 holes due to weather. Sophomore Paula Miranda led the team, tying for 33rd place with a 196.

WOMEN'S SOCCER

Head Coach: Dave Dilanni

Season Record: 5-6-7 Overall (2-3-5 B1G)

Notables: Iowa registered its first ranked win of the season over No. 13 Northwestern in Evanston on Oct. 20. It was the fifth ranked win against a top-15 foe in program history. The Hawkeyes posted a record of 2-2-3 in the month of October. Hailey Rydberg was named third team All-Big Ten. Ellie Otto earned the sportsmanship award for lowa.

VOLLEYBALL

Head Coach: Jim Barnes

Season Record: 7-16 Overall (1-11 B1G)
Next Event: Friday at Rutgers - 6 p.m. (CT)

Notables: Senior libero Mari Hinkle averages 4.23 digs per set which ranks third in the Big Ten. She is second the conference in total digs registering 351 thus far. Senior middle hitter Amiya Jones is ranked second in the conference for total aces (36) and third for aces per set (.43). Redshirt senior setter Lily Tessier is ranked eighth in the Big Ten in total assists (606) and ninth in assists per set (7.30).
