Barnes also discussed Xtreme arena, how it is a tremendous venue for his team, and the great atmosphere it creates for the fan base the team has generated.

Coach Barnes opened the floor to questions from the Committee. Questions were addressed and answered on the competitive Big Ten conference, how the roster will adjust next year, and recruiting styles.

Barta reported on the following:





FEBRUARY REPORT TO THE PRESIDENTIAL COMMITTEE ON ATHLETICS

MEN'S BASKETBALL

Head Coach: Fran McCaffery

Season Record: 14-8 Overall (6-5 B1G)

Next Event: Saturday vs. #-/25 Illinois - 1:30 p.m. at Carver-

Hawkeye Arena (FOX)

Notables: Iowa has started a three-game home stand with a pair of victories this week, first over Rutgers followed by a win over Northwestern. The Hawkeyes are 11-2 this season inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

Eleven of Iowa's 14 wins this season have come by double digits. Iowa is 9-1 when making nine or more 3-pointers in a single game.

Junior Kris Murray ranks 18th nationally in points per game (20.6 ppg). He was named third team midseason All-America by *Sporting News*, and is on the Wooden Award Late Season Top 20 List, Oscar Robertson Midseason Watch List, and Karl Malone Award Watch List. He ranks second in the Big Ten in scoring.

Senior Filip Rebraca has posted a team-best nine doubles-doubles, which ties for third most in the conference. He is one of seven players nationally to average 14+ points, 8+ rebounds, 1+ block, while shooting 57 percent or better from the field.

The Hawkeyes rank 10th in the country in assist-toturnover ratio, and 19th in assists, fewest turnovers and fewest fouls per contest. Iowa has made 77 more free throws (354) than its opponents have attempted (277).

WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

Head Coach: Lisa Bluder

Season Record: 17-4 Overall, (9-1 B1G)

Next Event: Thursday vs. #10 Maryland - 7:30 p.m. at

Carver-Hawkeye Arena (ESPN)

Notables: The Hawkeyes won 12 of their last 13 games dating back to Dec. 4, 2022. Iowa is currently ranked Top 10 in the nation in the Associated Press and USA Today Coaches Poll. Iowa knocked off two ranked foes on the road in month of January. Iowa's road win at No. 2 Ohio State was the highest ranked road victory in school history. The Hawkeyes are second in the Big Ten standings.

All-American Caitlin Clark has been breaking records as of late. She tied for the fastest Division I women's basketball player to reach 2,000 career points. She recently added to her Big Ten Conference record with her eighth career tripledouble, third-most in NCAA history, in Iowa's win at No. 2/2 Ohio State. Clark, who joined Marquette men's basketball All-American Dwyane Wade as the only NCAA Division I players since 1999-2000 with a triple-double against an AP top-2 opponent (Wade did it vs. No. 1 Kentucky in the 2003 NCAA Tournament), finished with 28 points, 10 rebounds

and a season-high 15 assists, the latter total tying for the third-most assists ever in a conference game. Of Clark's eight career triple-doubles, four have featured 25-point outings, the most in NCAA Division I history.

Fifth-year Monika Czinano has had an excellent stretch as of late, shooting better than 70% from the floor in five out of the last six games for the Hawkeyes

This week, Clark and Czinano were also named Wooden Award Late Season Watch List. Clark also was named to the Nancy Lieberman Point Guard of the Year Late Season Watch List.

FOOTBALL

Head Coach: Kirk Ferentz

Season Record: 8-5 Overall (5-4 B1G) **Next Event:** Spring Practice begins in March

Notables: Iowa closed the season with a 21-0 win over Kentucky in the TransPerfect Music City Bowl in Nashville. With the win, Iowa is one of six teams nationally to win at least eight games in every season since 2015, except for Covid shortened 2020.

As was the case throughout the season, the lowa defense came up big in the bowl victory, as freshman Xavier Nwankpa and sophomore Cooper DeJean had interception returns for two of lowa's three touchdowns.

DeJean also led Iowa's special teams play and was named the Most Valuable Player in the game.

Senior linebacker Jack Campbell was the recipient of the William V. Campbell Trophy, which is considered as the academic Heisman Trophy for college football. Campbell also won the Butkus Award as the top linebacker in the nation. Campbell concluded his career as lowa's 13th unanimous consensus All-American.

WOMEN'S GOLF

Notables: The Hawkeyes dropped a points scrimmage, 14.5-9.5, against Colorado on Jan. 30 in Chandler, Arizona. The two teams squared off head-to-head over 18 holes with the front nine, back nine and overall round accounting for points. Freshman Riley Lewis had two points to lead the team.

The Hawkeyes open the spring season Feb. 12-14, traveling to New Orleans for the Tulane Classic, presented by Chad Brownstein. Iowa will play six spring tournaments in Louisiana, Arizona, Florida, South Carolina, California and Ohio before the Big Ten Championships in Pittsburgh in April.

WOMEN'S GYMNASTICS

Season Record: 0-1-1 Overall (0-1-1 Big Ten) **Next Event:** Monday at Nebraska - 8 p.m. (BTN)

Notables: The Hawkeyes opened their season finishing second at the Super 16 and third at the Wasatch Classic. Iowa tied the fifth-best score in program history at No. 10 Ohio State scoring a 196.900. Iowa tied with No. 15 Minnesota scoring the seventh highest score in program history, a 196.875. Two Hawkeyes scored a near perfect 9.975 score against Minnesota: JerQuavia Henderson on floor and Linda Zivat on Vault.

SWIMMING & DIVING

Head Coach: Nathan Mundt

Season Record: 1-7-1 Overall (0-6 Big Ten)

Next Event: Feb. 15-18 at B1G Championships - Ann Arbor,

Mich.

Notables: The Hawkeyes registered nine event wins in their final home meet of the season to tie with Vanderbilt at 131. The Hawkeye victorious included the quartet of senior Kennedy Gilbertson, graduate student Sheridan Schreiber, freshman Scarlet Martin, and sophomore Molly Pedersen in the 200-medley relay, sophomore Alix O'Brien in the 1000 free, Gilbertson in the 100 back and 100 free, freshman Sabina Kupcova in the 50 and 200 free, Ozkazanc in the 200 back, Martin in the 100 fly and Gilbertson, Kupcova, Pedersen and Martin in the 400 free relay.

Against Illinois (Jan. 13-14), sophomore Makayla Hughbanks scored 348.15 (3-meter) and a career-best 311.55 (1-meter) to sweep the dive events. Freshman Lainey Woodward scored a career-high 302.85 to place second off the 1-meter springboards, ranking 11th all-time at lowa.

The Hawkeyes won the team title at the Larry Wieczorek. Following a strong showing at this past weekend's Razorback Invitational, the Hawkeyes are ranked 2nd in the Midwest region. They are also ranked nationally in seven event groups, including their highest rankings of 3rd in the 60-meter hurdles.

WRESTLING

Notables: The Hawkeyes dropped their first dual of the season, falling 23-14 at No. 1 Penn State on Jan. 27. Iowa won two of the first three matches and led 14-9 through six bouts, but the Nittany Lions won the final four matches to win the dual.

Two Hawkeyes – No. 1 Spencer Lee and No. 2 Real Woods – are both undefeated this season. Lee, who is a two-time Big Ten Wrestler of the Week honoree, is 11-0 with 11 bonus point victories, while Woods is 10-0. Woods has won four consecutive matches against ranked foes.

All 10 Hawkeyes are ranked in the various national rankings, including three in the top three (Lee, Woods and Cassioppi).
