Chair Zaharis called the meeting to order at 4:03 pm.

I. Approval of the February 2, 2023, PCA Minutes

Pettys moved to approve the February 2, 2023, minutes; Hanley seconded the motion. Unanimous approval was recorded from the Committee.

II. Head Coach Introduction – Kirk Ferentz, Head Football Coach

Chair Zaharis introduced Ferentz highlighting his time as the Head Football Coach at Iowa and success he has had on and off the field.

Ferentz thanked the Committee for their investment in the Athletics Department. Coach started by addressing the progression of facilities throughout his time at Iowa and how it has a direct correlation to both their success and how their program operates. Coach went into further detail of the team's training process and a typically schedule for their student-athletes.

Coach discussed recruiting including aspects that are now affecting the process including the transfer portal and NIL. At the core, the program remains consistent with developing student athletes with a focus on relationships.

Questions from the Committee were asked regarding student-athlete physical and mental health and academics. Coach highlighted the strength, nutrition, athletic training, sports psychology, and academic departments that support the program in these areas.

Chair Zaharis thanked Coach Ferentz for his time speaking to the Committee.

III. Changes in College Athletics – Senior Staff (Barta, Clerry, Goetz)

Barta, Clerry, and Goetz presented on the enclosed slide deck relating to the current changes in college athletics. Topics highlighted included legal issues, name, image, and likeness, legislation, the transfer portal, and updates on the Big Ten integration. Barta concluded the presentation by acknowledging how the department's value statement "Win. Graduate. Do It Right." is still the driving force.

Chair Zaharis highlighted Athletics continuously providing the guest speaker and coaches to speak to the Committee.

V. Athletics Department Searches – Cavey-Lang

Cavey- Lang reported the current search of an Assistant Women's Soccer Coach.

Chair Zaharis reported on behalf of Vogan. The Subcommittees most recent meeting focused on graduation rates (currently at 88%) and how Athletics is working to both maintain and improve these numbers.

The Subcommittee, combined with the Student-Athlete Well-Being, met with Lorenda Holston to discuss the Pregnancy and Parenting Policy. Focuses included pregnancy, post-partum, special needs, and return to both play following pregnancy.

C. Student-Athlete Well-Being – Voss

The Subcommittee combined with Diversity, Equity, Inclusion Subcommittee this past month. Refer to Diversity, Equity, Inclusion section for an overview of topics discussed during the meeting.

IX. Athletic Director's Report – Barta


Barta reported on the enclosed sport schedule. Highlighting the following competitions and success:

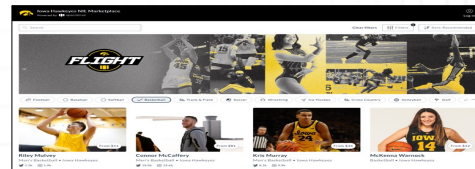

Standardized Tests

The standardized test score requirement was eliminated from the initial-eligibility requirements and established GPA requirements.

- The Sliding Scale was eliminated; thus, establishing a 2.300 minimum GPA in 16 core courses.
- Effective August 1, 2023. For Students enrolling in Fall of 2023.

Coaching Staff Size

- Eliminate volunteer coaches and increase the number of countable coaches permitted. (Effective July 1, 2023)
- Remove Graduate Assistant Coaches in Rowing & Swim/Dive. Alter FB Grad Assistant
- Most sports increased their countable coach limit by 1 coach (for example Baseball goes from 3 to 4 countable coaches)
- Exceptions are Rowing going from 4 to 7; Track and Field/XC going from 3 to 6 (per gender)

Basketball Staff Size

In Basketball, increase the coaching limitation from 4 to 6 who may be employed.

- The 2 additional coaches shall not contact or evaluate recruits off-campus and are subject to the IAWP legislation.
- Effective July 1, 2023.

Established transfer portal windows based on sport season of when a student may enter the portal.

- Exception to the portal windows:
 - Non-scholarship, non recruited
 - Graduate transfer

Transfer Waiver Update

“4-4-4” transfers, more restrictive guidelines for approval:

- Student-athlete physical injury or illness, student-athlete mental health and diagnosed education impacting disability guidelines;
- Additionally, the Council affirmed that undergraduate transfer waivers submitted based on academic reasons (e.g., degree offered does not meet expectations, change of major) or athletics reasons (e.g., reduced playing time, change of position) will be denied.

MARCH REPORT TO THE PRESIDENTIAL COMMITTEE ON ATHLETICS

BASEBALL

Head Coach: Rick Heller

Season Record: 5-1 Overall (0-0 Big Ten)

Next Event: Tuesday vs. Loras at 4 p.m. - Duane Banks Field

Notables: Iowa took down the #1 LSU Tigers on Feb. 25, 12-4 at the Round Rock Classic. Sophomore pitcher Brody Brecht got the start, before bullpen arms of redshirt senior Jared Simpson and redshirt junior Will Christophersen slammed the door on the Tigers. Iowa led 7-2 after four innings and used 16 hits to beat LSU. Graduate student Brennan Dorighi recorded three hits (including a double and home run), five RBIs, and two runs scored to lead Iowa offensively. The Hawkeyes finished 2-1 at the Round Rock Classic, falling to Sam Houston and beating Kansas State.

The Hawkeyes opened the season in Port Charlotte, Fla., earning three wins at the Snowbird Baseball Classic. Iowa beat Indiana State (6-2) on Opening Day with a walk-off grand slam from redshirt junior Kyle Huckstorf in the 11th inning. The Hawkeyes finished the weekend with dominant wins over Quinnipiac (7-1, 10-0). Brecht threw five perfect innings during his start on Saturday.

MEN'S BASKETBALL

Head Coach: Fran McCaffery

Season Record: 18-11 Overall (10-8 B1G)

Next Event: Tuesday at Indiana - 6 p.m. (ESPN2)

Notables: The Hawkeyes became one of just four teams in Division I history to trail by 11+ points and win with under one minute remaining in the game when it rallied from 11 points with 55 seconds left to upend Michigan State in overtime (112-106) on Feb. 25 in Iowa City. Iowa made five 3-pointers over the final 39 seconds of regulation to send the game into overtime. The 218 points were the most combined points scored in a men's basketball in the 40-year history of Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

Iowa has 12 combined Quad 1 (4) and Quad 2 (8) wins on its resume, second most in the Big Ten behind Purdue (14).

Fran McCaffery (125) is one win from tying Tom Davis (126) for the most regular season Big Ten victories in program history.

Iowa has won 10 or more Big Ten games eight of the last nine seasons.

All-America candidate Kris Murray and UNC Asheville's Drew Pember are the only Division I players in the country to average 20+ points, 8+ rebounds, and have made 50+ 3-pointers this season. Murray, who ranks 22nd nationally in points per game, surpassed 500 points this season in Iowa's last game versus Michigan State on Saturday.

Sixth-year senior Connor McCaffery has once again ascended to ranking first in the country in assist-to-turnover ratio (4.21) this season.

Iowa has won seven straight home games and are 14-2 overall at home this season. The Hawkeyes have won 14+ home games each of the last five years.

Iowa is third in the country in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.66), 13th in fewest turnovers per game (10.0), 15th in assists per game (16.6), 20th in scoring offense (80.4), and 31st in fewest fouls per game (14.8).

WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

Head Coach: Lisa Bluder

Season Record: 23-6 Overall, (15-3 B1G)

Next Event: Friday vs. winner of Wisconsin vs. Purdue at B1G Tournament - 5:30 p.m. - Minneapolis, Minn. (BTN)

Notables: The Hawkeyes finished the B1G regular season with 15 victories which is the most in the Bluder era. Iowa also ended up knocking off four AP Top 10 teams which is the most in school history.

Most recently, College GameDay made its first ever appearance inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena and it was one of three women's basketball shows this season. Iowa ended up knocking off No. 2 Indiana in dramatic fashion from a buzzer beating Caitlin Clark 3-pointer, 86-85. Clark is a National Player of the Year candidate and leads the country in assists and is top-3 in scoring.

Bluder has led the Hawkeyes to seven straight 20-win seasons and has won 14 or more Big Ten conference games in four out of the last five seasons.

MEN'S GOLF

Head Coach: Tyler Stith

Next Event: Mar. 6-7 at Wake Forest Invite - Pinehurst, N.C.

Notables: The Hawkeyes finished ninth at the Puerto Rico Classic earlier this month. Iowa placed ahead of No. 28 Purdue and No. 45 Marquette competing in 13-team field that featured eight ranked squads at Grand Reserve Golf Club. Senior Ronan Kleu and junior Callum Macfie were Iowa's low finishers, tying for 28th on the leaderboard shooting -3 (213) through 54 holes.

WOMEN'S GOLF

Head Coach: Megan Menzel

Next Event: Mar. 6-7 at UNF Collegiate – Jacksonville, Fla.

Notables: Freshman Madison Dabagia's first career top 10 finish propelled the Hawkeye women's golf team to a fifth-place team finish at the Tulane Classic presented by Chad Brownstein earlier this month. The Hawkeyes shot a final round 305 to finish with a 54-hole total of 919 (315-299-305) at English Turn Golf and Country Club.

The Hawkeyes were in 12th place through the first two rounds of the Westbrook Spring Invite in Peoria, Ariz. Play is scheduled to be completed on Monday.

GYMNASTICS

Head Coach: Larissa Libby

Season Record: 3-1-1 Overall (3-1-1 Big Ten)

Next Event: Saturday vs. Iowa State at 5 p.m. - Carver-Hawkeye Arena - Iowa Corn-Cy-Hawk Series

Notables: The Hawkeyes scored a season-high 196.925 to place second at the Big Five Meet last Friday. Iowa is ranked 20th nationally with a 196.541 average. Senior Linda Zivat, freshman Karina Muñoz, and senior JerQuavia Henderson (2x) all earned Big Ten Weekly Honors in February. Iowa is ranked in the Top 25 in three events as a team: No. 13 on floor, No. 17 on vault, and No. 18 on beam.

SOFTBALL

Head Coach: Renee Gillespie

Season Record: 8-6 Overall (0-0 B1G)

Next Event: Friday-Sunday at Adam Brown Memorial Shamrock Classic - Conway, Ark.

Notables: The Hawkeyes opened their season as the FAU Paradise Classic going 4-1, including a 2-0 win over No. 23 Mississippi St. This past weekend at the Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic in Cathedral City, Calif., they went toe-to-toe with No. 1 UCLA, losing 2-1 on a late inning home run.

Through the first three weeks of the season, the Hawkeyes are being led offensively by senior Nia Carter who is hitting .512 through 14 games. Junior Denali Loecker is hitting .400 and leads the team in home runs (4) and RBIs (17). In the circle freshman Jalen Adams has thrown 26.2 innings and boast a 0.79 ERA in six appearances with a .196 opponent batting average against.

SWIMMING & DIVING

Head Coach: Nathan Mundt

Season Record: 1-7-1 Overall (0-6 Big Ten)

Next Event: Mar. 6-9 at NCAA Zone D Diving Championships - Minneapolis, Minn.

Notables: In a last chance effort to qualify for the NCAA Championships on March 15-18, senior Kennedy Gilbertson broke the 100-yard backstroke school record in 53.19 at Purdue on Feb. 25.

At the Big Ten Championships, the Hawkeyes finished 12th with 198 points.

TENNIS

Head Coach: Sasha Schmid

Season Record: 4-4 Overall (0-0 B1G)

Next Event: Saturday vs. Wisconsin at Noon – Minneapolis

Notables: The Hawkeyes are ranked No. 40 nationally. Iowa went 3-3 during the month of February. The Hawkeyes beat Denver and Kansas State at home and bounced Saint Mary's on the West Coast on a neutral court. Freshman Dianne Hayashida leads the team with five singles victories this spring.

MEN'S TRACK & FIELD

Head Coach: Joey Woody

Next Event: Mar. 8-11 at NCAA Indoor Championships - Albuquerque, N.M

Notables: The Hawkeyes placed third at the B1G Indoor Championships. Senior James Carter Jr. and juniors Grant Conway, Peyton Haack and Austin West have qualified for the NCAA meet. Junior Tyler Olson (1:16.13 – 600 meters) and Carter Jr. (15.91 meter | 52' 2.50" – triple jump) earned second-team all-Big Ten honors. At the Iowa Open on Feb. 17, junior Austin Kresley sprinted a 6.64 in the 60-meter dash, climbing to second all-time in school history.

WOMEN'S TRACK & FIELD

Head Coach: Joey Woody

Next Event: Mar. 8-11 at NCAA Indoor Championships - Albuquerque, N.M

Notables: Junior Myreanna Bebe broke her own school record and won the Big Ten title in the 60-meter hurdles, crossing the line in 8.07. Bebe's performance helped Iowa finish third in the team standings. She has also qualified for the NCAA meet. Senior LaSarah Hargrove earned second-team all-Big Ten honors with her 23.37 in the 200-meter dash. Freshman Audrey Biermann ran a 53.28 in the 400-meters, climbing to sixth in school history. Junior Ali Dorn zipped to a 1:29.03 in the 600-meters, recording the seventh fastest time in Hawkeye history. Junior Alli Bookin-Nosbisch set the new school record in the 800-meter race (2:04.28) at the Music City Challenge in Nashville on Feb.11.

WRESTLING

Head Coach: Tom Brands

Season Record: 15-1 Overall (7-1 B1G)

Next Event: Saturday-Sunday at B1G Championships - Ann Arbor, Mich.

Notables: The Hawkeyes finished the dual season with a 15-1 overall record, including a 7-1 mark in the Big Ten to finish second in the league standings.

Iowa closed out the year with a 28-7 victory over No. 6 Oklahoma State in Carver-Hawkeye Arena. The Hawkeyes won eight of the 10 bouts, including a 51-second fall from top-ranked Spencer Lee at 125. It was his eighth fall of the season and his 52nd straight win. Lee finished his career with a 26-0 record in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

Lee was selected as the Big Ten Wrestler of the Week on Feb. 21 – his third honor of the season and the seventh of his career.

The Hawkeyes have all 10 wrestlers ranked and six wrestlers in the top 10 of the coaches' rankings heading into the postseason. Iowa will travel to Ann Arbor, Michigan, for the 2023 Big Ten Championships on March 4-5. The event is the automatic qualifying tournament for the NCAA Championships.
