# MAY REPORT TO THE PRESIDENTIAL COMMITTEE ON ATHLETICS

## BASEBALL

**Head Coach:** Rick Heller

**Season Record:** 26-15 Overall (10-5 Big Ten)

**Next Event:** Friday-Sunday vs. Purdue - Iowa City

**Notables:** Iowa has won three Big Ten straight series and four of its last five, which puts it in fourth place in the league standings with three weeks to go in the regular season. The top eight teams qualify for the Big Ten Tournament in Omaha.

Iowa's pitching staff has been one of the nation's best, ranking second nationally in strikeouts per nine innings (11.8) and hits allowed per nine innings (6.35), while ranking eighth in ERA (3.50). The Hawkeyes lead the Big Ten in ERA, fewest hits allowed (260), fewest runs allowed (175), strikeouts (480) and batting average against (.198). The staff is on the cusp of breaking the program's single-season strikeouts record (499).

Redshirt sophomore Adam Mazur is 3-0 with a 0.72 ERA over his last three starts, going at least eight innings in all three starts. Mazur threw a complete game shutout, scattering two hits and fanning six in a 1-0 road win at Nebraska on April 29. It was Iowa's first complete game shutout since 2016.

Iowa has two of the top sluggers in the Big Ten in redshirt sophomore Peyton Williams and redshirt freshman Keaton Anthony. Williams is leading the Big Ten in on-base percentage (.497), while ranking second in slugging (.699), OPS (1.196) and fourth in batting average (.379). Williams has a team-best 10 home runs to go along with 33 RBIs. Anthony is hitting .347 with team-highs in doubles (18) and RBIs (38), while hitting eight home runs.

The Hawkeyes have earned a school-record eight Big Ten weekly honors this season – Mazur (2), Anthony (4), Connor Schultz (1), Williams (1).

## MEN'S GOLF

**Head Coach:** Tyler Stith

**Notables:** The Hawkeyes concluded their season with a seventh-place finish at the Big Ten Championships. Iowa placed second at the Hawkeye Invitational, April 16-17, finishing two strokes behind No. 30 Kansas. Iowa hosted the Calusa Cup, April 3-5, in Naples, Florida, which featured seven of the nation's top 25 ranked teams at the time.

Juniors Mac McClear and Ronan Kleu were named second team All-Big Ten honorees. Sophomore Callum Macfie earned Big Ten Sportsmanship Award recognition. This season, McClear led the Hawkeyes with a 72.3 stroke average through 30 rounds of golf. The Hinsdale, Illinois, native posted seven top 25 finishes in Iowa's 10 outings,

including four top 10 finishes and a fifth-place effort at the Hawkeye Invitational.

McClear posted a career low round of 64 on Feb. 15 at the Puerto Rico Classic, matching the third-lowest 18-hole round in program history. He finished at 203 (-13) at that event to secure the low Hawkeye 54-hole score of the season.

Kleu's recognition comes in his first season at Iowa. The Swiss native was previously Peach Belt Conference Player of the Year in 2021 at Columbus State, where he earned first team All-PBC honors in 2020. This season, Kleu was second on the team with a 72.9 stroke average and posted two top 10 finishes at the Marquette Invite (tied for sixth) and Notre Dame Fighting Irish Classic (tied for eighth).

## WOMEN'S GOLF

**Head Coach:** Megan Menzel

**Notables:** The Hawkeyes finished 14th at the Big Ten Championships with a 54-hole total of 928 strokes. Iowa's highest finisher was Jacque Galloway, who tied for 58th with a 231.

Freshman Paula Miranda posted the seventh-best spring scoring average in program history, finishing with a 75.60 clip. Senior Dana Lerner was the recipient of Iowa's Big Ten Sportsmanship Award.

## WOMEN'S GYMNASTICS

**Head Coach:** Larissa Libby

**Season Record:** 11-6 Overall (5-4 Big Ten)

**Notables:** Sophomore Adeline Kenlin finished as the national runner-up on the balance beam at the NCAA Championships in Fort Worth, Texas. It was the highest place ever by a Hawkeye gymnast.

The Iowa City, Iowa, native posted a 9.950, competing as an individual, to finish second to Olympic Gold Medalist Suni Lee. Kenlin earned first-team All-America honors, becoming the sixth All-American at the NCAA meet in program history and the second on the beam.

The Hawkeyes posted five of the top nine team scores in program history during the regular season, including 197.075, the second-best mark all-time, in the NCAA Regional Final. Iowa finished the year ranked No. 14 in the Road to Nationals rankings.

## **ROWING**

**Head Coach:** Jeff Garbutt

**Next Event:** May 15 at Big Ten Championships - Indianapolis, Indiana

**Notables:** Iowa captured five victories during its first home regatta – the Big Ten-Pac 12 Challenge – on April 29 at the Coralville Reservoir. Iowa got two wins from the second varsity four, two wins from the third varsity four and one from the third varsity eight. The Hawkeyes earned their fourth Big Ten Boat of the Week honor on May 3 when the 2V4 earned the distinction. The four honors are the most in a single season in program history.

## **SOFTBALL**

**Head Coach:** Renee Gillespie

**Season Record:** 19-29 Overall (2-18 Big Ten)

**Next Event:** Friday-Sunday vs. Purdue - Iowa City

**Notables:** Two Hawkeyes are batting .300 and up (junior outfielder Nia Carter with .385 and junior infielder Sophia Maras .300). Six Hawkeyes have at least 18 RBIs, with sophomore RHP Denali Loecker leading the pack with 25. Iowa has scored 189 runs in 48 games.

The home run count for the season is currently at 25: Loecker has 10, freshman catcher Tristin Doster has five, junior infielder Kalena Burns has four, sophomore catcher Marissa Peek and sophomore outfielder Brylee Klosterman have two, and senior outfielder Riley Sheehy and freshman infielder Maggie Vasa have one.

## **TENNIS**

**Head Coach:** Sasha Schmid

**Season Record:** 7-17 Overall (2-10 Big Ten)

**Notables:** Iowa won three of its final six matches, including its Big Ten Opening Round match versus Michigan State (4-3). The Hawkeyes also won at Michigan State in the regular season and at Rutgers. Iowa played a daunting schedule, competing against 12 ranked opponents, including three of their last four.

Freshman Barbora Pokorna led the squad with 13 singles victories, competing at every spot in the lineup except No. 1. Senior Samantha Mannix and sophomore Vipasha Mehra each won nine matches, while freshman Marisa Schmidt tallied eight wins, including a team-best six at No. 1.

## **MEN'S TRACK & FIELD**

**Head Coach:** Joey Woody

**Next Event:** Saturday at Dr. Tucker Open - Dubuque, Iowa

**Notables:** The Hawkeyes have broken seven school records this outdoor season; sophomore Kalen Walker (100 meters), sophomore Jeniah McKiver (400 meters); freshman Max Murphy (1,500 meters); Walker/freshman Austin Kresley/sophomore Gratt Reed/freshman Khullen

Jefferson (4x100-meter relay); sophomore Grant Conway/senior Josh Braverman/freshman Kalil Johnson/Reed (shuttle-hurdle relay); senior Nik Curtiss (shot put); and sophomore Austin West (decathlon).

McKiver leads the NCAA with the fastest 400-meter time this season (44.74). He was named USTFCCA National Men's Athlete of the Week and Big Ten Track Men's Athlete of the Week on April 12 for his performance. His time was No. 2 in the world for 2022 at the time. West is ranked second in the NCAA with his 8,179-point total in the decathlon.

The Hawkeyes won the Drake Relays Cup in Des Moines with 36 points – the first Cup title for Iowa since 2018 and third overall. Junior James Carter, Jr. became the first university division men's athlete to sweep the horizontal jumps (long jump, triple jump) at the Drake Relays in 16 years. Additionally, the shuttle-hurdle relay team of Conway, Braverman, Johnson and Reed won for the first time since 1984 – the fourth overall Drake shuttle-hurdle title in program history, while breaking the school record. The sprint-medley relay team of Kresley, Khullen Jefferson, junior Julien Gillum and junior Alec Still also won a Drake Relays title with fifth-fastest time in school history.

## **WOMEN'S TRACK & FIELD**

**Head Coach:** Joey Woody

**Next Event:** Saturday at Dr. Tucker Open - Dubuque, Iowa

**Notables:** Sophomore LaSarah Hargrove (22.79) ran the second-fastest time in program history on April 9 at the Jim Click Shootout - second to only current 100-meter world leader and Iowa alum Brittany Brown. The 4x100-meter relay team of Hargrove, freshman Lia Love, senior Erin Dowd and freshman Paige Magee ran 44.06 - just two-hundredths of a second off the school record. Hargrove was named Big Ten Women's Track Athlete of the Week on April 12 for her performance.

Junior Amanda Howe improved her own school record in the hammer throw at home during the Musco Twilight on April 23. The 400-meter hurdle group led by Dowd (57.27, No. 14) features four women under 58.3 seconds, all of whom rank inside the NCAA top-35. Junior Mariel Bruxvoort (57.73, No. 19), senior Payton Wensel (57.77, No. 21) and Magee (58.26, No. 35) round out the best top-four 400-meter hurdlers in the nation, as they have had the No. 1 event squad every week this season in the USTFCCA Event Squad Rankings.
