1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 4:03 pm.

2. Approval of the October 7, 2025, PCA Minutes

Hand moved to approve the October 7, 2025, minutes; Hanley seconded the motion; unanimous approval was granted.

3. Head Coach – Stacy May-Johnson

Chair Pierce introduced Coach May-Johnson as the sixth coach in program history. He highlighted her playing career at Iowa and the positive impact of her return.

Stacy May-Johnson emphasized her goals for the program, including establishing a new culture within the program, recruiting talent from Iowa, maintaining high academic standards, and building sustainable on-field culture. She spoke on the importance of alumni engagement and the correlation it has to the development of the program.

Questions were received regarding facilities, roster, and the impact of women's professional sports.

4. Facilities Update - Simcox

Simcox recognized the grounds crew and their contributions to the flower displays across campus. He spoke on the enclosed slide deck focusing on current and completed facilities projects:

- Kinnick Stadium – concessions and premium seating.
- Carver-Hawkeye Arena – practice gym renovations.
- HTRC – resurfaced indoor courts.
- Control Room – new space in the third floor of carver.
- Duane Banks Field – new clubhouse facility for the team.

5. Searches - Hanley

Hanley noted there are no active searches at this time.

6. Chair Report – Pierce

Chair Pierce had nothing to report on at this time.

7. Subcommittee Reports

Academic Achievement - Hand

The Subcommittee met with a group of four student-athletes last week. Discussion was had on majors, the impact of NIL, tutoring, and life after graduation. Time management was addressed as a common challenge for student athletes.

Policy and Legislative Compliance – Sterling

The Subcommittee met to review its new responsibilities including reviewing NCAA attestations. Sterling noted the lengthy list of past, present, and upcoming attestations.

Student-Athlete Well-Being – Reisinger

The Subcommittee received a presentation from ISAAC on the general structure of the Committee and updates from the subcommittees. Discussion was had around transitioning out of sport, resources that are available for students, and sports wagering awareness.

Smith reported on the following items:

9. NCAA/Big Ten/Athletic Director's Report – Goetz

Goetz provided the following departmental updates:

- Enjoyable and busy time of the year with fall sports starting their championship segments and winter sports starting competition.
- Game Day Enhancements: adjustments have been to enhance the game day environment at Carver through increased fan engagement, improved PA reads, DJ located in the student section, and in seat ordering for premium seating.
- Recruiting: signing period starts next week for all sports except football.

Questions were received and answered around transfer windows and sports wagering.

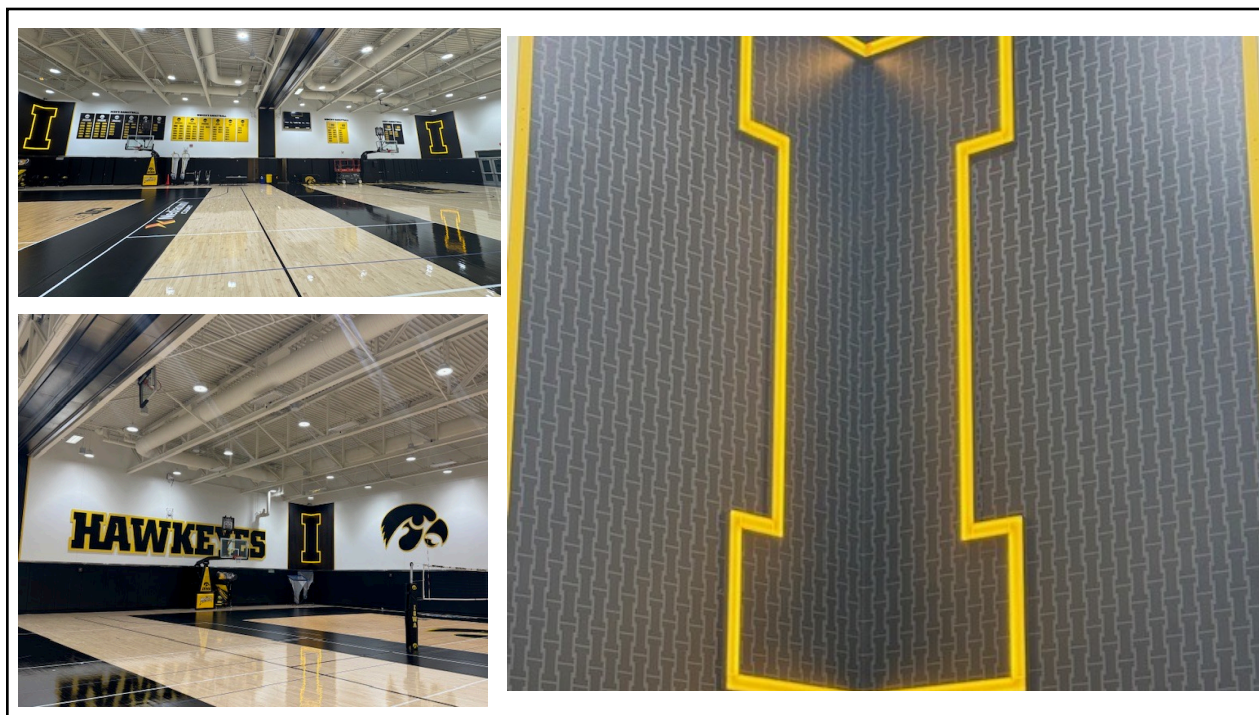

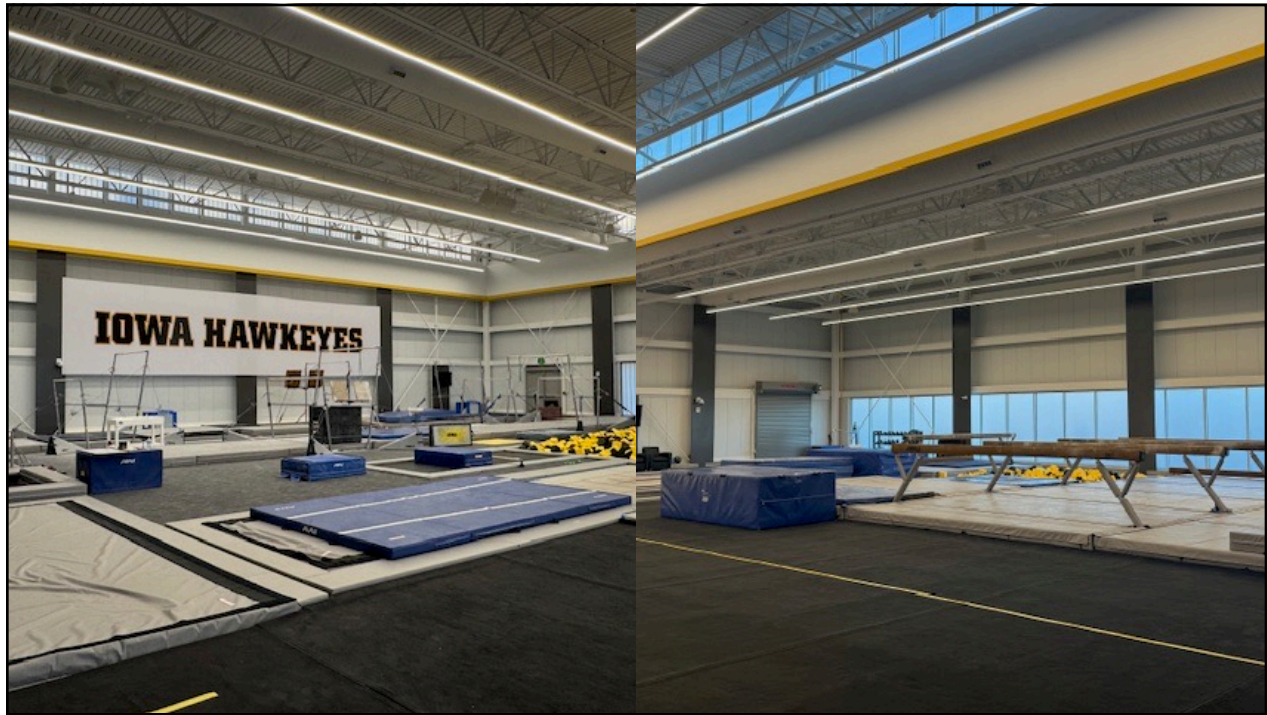

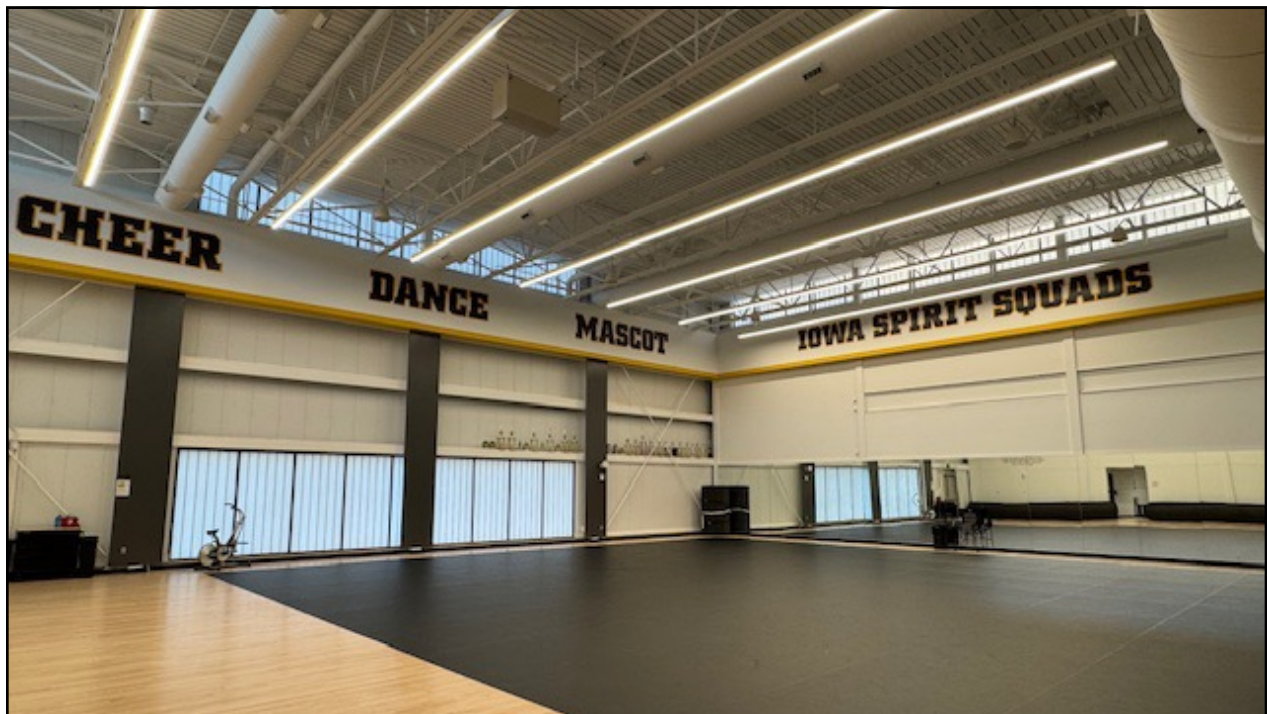
